In 1984, the Methodist Study Trust was established by the Methodist Church (English Speaking) (now renamed as Methodist International Church, Hong Kong) through the generous donations from its church members and has been administered by Yang Memorial Methodist Social Service. The aim of the Study Trust is to enable disabled and deprived family students to complete their education by providing financial support to them on school-related expenses.



From a young age, I have been determined to pursue a career in the healthcare industry, aspiring to become a professional healthcare worker and use my abilities to help others. However, the path to realizing my dreams has not been easy, especially when faced with the challenges of Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE). I am well aware that I must exert greater effort in my studies.

Due to limited family finances, I could not afford additional tutoring fees, yet HKDSE results are crucial for my future enrollment in a university healthcare program. Particularly in subjects like English composition and Biology, I have consistently felt inadequate. English composition demands flexible expression skills and a solid language foundation, while Biology involves a plethora of complex theories and application questions—areas where I needed to strengthen my weaknesses.

Just as I was feeling anxious about this, the Methodist Study Trust reached out to lend me a helping hand. This bursary provided me with a rare opportunity to participate in supplementary courses tailored for the HKDSE. Through these classes, I not only acquired practical answering techniques but also gained a deeper understanding of the exam formats and grading criteria. Teachers offered professional guidance on my weaknesses, such as structuring clear paragraphs in English composition and efficiently memorizing key knowledge and applying it to practical Biology questions. This assistance gradually restored my confidence and clarified my learning direction.

This bursary is not just financial support, it is a validation of my dreams. It made me realize that there are many people in society willing to help students achieve their goals. This warmth and encouragement have strengthened my determination to pursue a career in healthcare. Last year, I applied for help from the MethodistStudy Trust because my financial situation in Hong Kong is not very good. My parents are not allowed to work here, which means we do not have a lot of money. This makes it hard for us to pay for daily needs and school expenses.

When I had my interview with the Methodist Study Trust, I shared my story with them. I explained my situation in Hong Kong and why I needed support. The people I talked to were very kind and understanding. They listened to me carefully and seemed interested in my life. They asked about my hobbies and what I want to do in the future. I felt comfortable talking to them because they were friendly.

During the interview, they told me that they were willing to help me as much as they could. They also encouraged me to apply for support next year if I face any more challenges. Their words motivated me to work hard to achieve my goals. I was happy to hear that they would also help me with my education after I graduate from school. As part of their support, they provided me with a good amount of money. The procedure was very fast, and I received the money in a short time. This money helped me pay for transportation, which is important because my house is far from my school and transportation costs can be high. I also used some of the money for school supplies, like stationery and textbooks, which I need for my studies.

My after-graduate plans are to apply for Lingnan University or Hong Kong Metropolitan University, and to take a course in pet academy. Learning about animals has always been my interest since I was young, and I would be very happy if I was able to learn more about animals. The course includes how to treat a pet, to learn more about their bodies and how to help them when they are injured. My other plan is to be a pastry chef. Since I was young, I have always helped my mom with baking, and as I got older, I started baking many pastries myself. I am not very sure which university has a course for pastry, so I am still looking forward to it.

自從2022年以來,我的家庭陷入債務和財務困境。更雪上加霜的是,我正在為大學入學考試做準備,我家每年花費約6萬港幣僅用於補習費,以獲得更好的學習資源。學習對我來說是最重要的,因為我認為這是我未來獲得更高生活品質的唯一途徑。起初,我幾乎無法專心學習,因為我擔心自己是否能在每個月底支付下一期的補習費。

在我高中的第二年,即2023年,我的社工告訴我關於MST。我申請並與捐助者進行了面談。從2023年到2025年,我總共收到了1萬1千港幣。雖然與我的補習費相比,這不是一個巨額預算,但它確實幫助我度過困難時期,應對財務壓力。因此,我不再總是擔心賬單,相反,我能夠更專注於我的學業進度。

此外,我想提到我的第二次申請面試是一次令人難忘的經歷。這次面試是在考試前5個月舉行的,我每天都感受到壓力。我認為捐助者和助學基金職員能感受到我的恐慌,因此他們說了許多支持和鼓勵的話。我終於感到被理解,被人情的溫暖打動。因此,我認為MST的意義不僅在於提供財務支持,幫助學生實現目標,還在於向世界傳遞善意。

I am Yennie, a student who was benefited by the Methodist Study Trust (MST) from 2023 to 2025. I would like to share my association with the MST.

Since 2022, my family has gotten into debts and financial difficulties. To add insult to injury, I was preparing for a college entrance exam and my family spent around 60 thousand Hong Kong dollars just on tutorial fees every year to gain better study resources. Studying was the biggest priority for me as I thought it was the only pathway for me to obtain a higher quality in future life. At the beginning, I could barely concentrate on studying because I was worrying whether I could pay the following tutorial fees at the end of every month.

In 2023, the second year of my high school, my social worker told me about the MST. I applied and had an interview with the donor. I received a total of 11000 Hong Kong dollars from 2023 to 2025. Although it was not a huge budget, compared to my tutorial fees, it did help me pass through the difficult times and cope with the financial stress. Thus, I did not have to always be concerned about the bills, instead, I was able to focus more on my study progress.

Moreover, I would like to mention that the interview for my second application was a memorable experience. It was held 5 months before the examination, and I was under pressure every single day. I thought the donor and the staff member could feel my panic, so they said a lot of supporting words and encouragement to me. I finally felt understood and I was touched by the warmth of human-beings. Therefore, I reckon that the meaning of the MST is not only to provide financial support to help students achieve their goals but also to spread kindness to the world.

Now, I am studying a bachelor's degree programme in architectural studies to pursue my dream. Thanks to the MST, I could be well-prepared for the examination and study the subject that I had been desiring to. I believe the MST will keep facilitating students' dreams and contributing more potential teens to the society. Last but not least, I would like to express my sincere appreciation to the MST, including the staff and the donors. The MST is truly carrying out "Enlighten Our Youth Generation, Brighten Their Future Vision".
